

Strategie přípravy žáků na zkoušky Cambridge English (webinář)

Podnadpis: Další výukové aktivity podporující rozvoj řečových dovedností žáků

Kurzem Vás provede **Mgr. Natalija Stančić** (webinář bude primárně veden v anglickém jazyce, ale lektorka hovoří i česky). V současné době pracuje jako metodik a lektor, její specializací je příprava na zkoušky Cambridge ESOL a využití metody DME (Direct method for English) ve výuce. Natalija pracovala v British Council, kde měla na starosti záležitosti spojené s přípravou, realizací a hodnocením jazykových Cambridge zkoušek.

Účastníci obdrží originální materiály a odkazy na online zdroje. Vždy bude zaslán i záznam z webináře.

The course is a systematic breakdown of the teacher's role in preparing students for the Cambridge First and Advanced exams (FCE & CAE); two most in demand exams among the elementary and high school student population. In the course, the teachers will familiarise themselves with the overall system of testing, role of the teacher, detailed presentation of each part of the exams, with the specific focus on WHAT is being tested and practical guidance on HOW to adequately prepare their students for the exams. Each session will look into designated parts of the test, what is being tested, how to approach each task and practical tips & tricks to maximise students' achievement.

Additionally, there will be a brief comparison between exam conditions during paper-based and digital exams (a recent introduction). Each participant will get a booklet summarising the course as well as a list of useful links that can help them explore the topic further. Each part will contain a Q&A session where teachers are encouraged to ask questions and actively participate in exchanging ideas. Finally, the content of the course is equally useful for developing students' skills outside of the Cambridge exams context.

First afternoon (Monday 19.1.2026 – 16.00-18.00)

- **Short general introduction to the exams (system, applicability, purpose, FCE vs CAE)**
- **Use of English and Reading** – types of tasks, target language structures and skills, strategy, and practical tips & tricks for teaching
- **Q&A session**

Second afternoon (Monday 2.2.2026 – 16.00-18.00)

- **Writing** – what is assessed, strategy and tips & tricks for teaching each type of writing (essay, review, article, story, report)
- **Listening** – types of tasks, target language structures and skills, strategy, and practical tips & tricks for teaching
- **Q&A session**

Third afternoon (Monday 16.2.2026 – 16.00-18.00)

- **Speaking** – video + types of tasks, target language structures and skills, strategy, and practical tips & tricks for teaching
- **Cambridge Advanced-specific tasks** – There are several differences in the types of tasks between First and Advanced. This section will focus on the types of tasks, target language structures and

skills, strategy, and practical tips & tricks for teaching those as well as the general difference in requirements between Cambridge First and Cambridge Advanced.
